- 2- Applied Sciences (Fresh graduate can't apply student need 2 years of work experience certificate)

▪ 03 years UG	▪ 3.5 years UG

For Undergraduate

- 10 years gap acceptable if student have 75% in UG and spouse is also allowed.
- Required IELTS for UG 6.0 and PTE is 58
- Student can get admission direct in UG without any foundation
